: Patient Responsibilities :

The following are the responsibilities of the patients

- Being responsible for their health and well being :
 - 1. Follow all the instructions given by physiotherapist.
 - 2. Follow all the instructions given by Doctor/ physician /surgeon.
 - 3. Adherence to physiotherapy protocols.
 - 4. During and after the treatment sessions follow healthy habits such as exercising and eating a healthy diet.
 - 5. Avoid smoking, alcohol consumption and substance abuse and eating a healthy diet.
 - 6. Prevent the spread of their disease.
 - 7. Understand the risks and limitations of the physiotherapy care.
 - 8. Understand that physiotherapy professional can make errors.
- Provide correct information regarding their health
 - 1. Inform if there is presence of pace makers in the body
 - 2. Inform for presence of metallic implants in the body
 - 3. Inform for presence of any skin reactions or allergies or skin infection if it is already
 - 4. Provide information if already diagnosed with hypertension, Diabetes, Mentally challenged vertigo, anxiety neurosis to the therapist.
 - 5. Report any wrong doing or fraud to the appropriate people or legal authorities
- Be financially and administratively responsible.
 - 1. Try to meet financial obligations.
 - 2. Follow all the administrative procedures for enrolling as patient both indoors as well as in case of out- patient departments.
 - 3. Provide all the documents if and when required for claim of health benefit programs both for institutional as well as for Government Schemes.
 - 4. If referred by doctors/surgeons / health care professionals in that case kindly provide all the investigative reports records , sheets, discharge summary .
 - 5. Kindly inform for discontinuance of treatment to the physiotherapist / health care professionals.
- Be respectful to others.
 - 1. Wait for your turn as every patient is equally important.
 - 2. In case of emergency situations priority to such patients to be given.
 - 3. Be aware that physiotherapist and healthcare provider's obligation to be reasonably efficient in providing the health care.
